**H.E. OHENEBA DR. LESLEY AKUA AKYAA OPOKU-WARE PRESENTS
LETTERS OF CREDENCE TO PRESIDENT VLADIMIR VLADIMIROVICH PUTIN,
AS GHANA'S AMBASSADOR EXTRAORDINARY AND PLENIPOTENTIARY TO
THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON WEDNESDAY 1ST DECEMBER, 2021**

The Embassy of the Republic of Ghana hereby informs that H.E. Oheneba Dr. Lesley Akua Akyaa Opoku-Ware, on Wednesday 1st December, 2021 presented her Letters of Credence accrediting her as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Ghana to the Russian Federation to President Vladimir Vladimirovich Putin at the Grand Kremlin Palace, Moscow.

Her Excellency Opoku-Ware and nineteen other new envoys were present for the ceremony.

In the President's address to the envoys, he expressed the willingness of Russia to cooperate with all countries to their mutual benefit based on equality and respect.

On global and regional issues, President Putin was concerned that international communities are not working together to solve global problems.

Touching on the bilateral relations between Ghana and the Russian Federation, President Putin noted that Russia's relations with the Republic of Ghana are developing steadily. The interaction in the field of trade and energy including peaceful nuclear development is being expanded. The Countries jointly produce minerals and hydrocarbons. He also said that Russia will continue to train professionals for various sectors of Ghana's economy.
